Zero Hunger, Quality Education, Sustainable Cities and Communities, Good Health and Well-being, Reduced Inequalities














This year, Reduced Inequalities became one of our top goals, while last year Responsible Consumption and Production was in the top 5.

# Mapping against each SDGs and their targets: 2020 and 2021 compared

This year we mapped 70 of our current programs and projects against the SDGs and their targets: aligning to 14/17 SDGs, and 62/169 targets.



### **An important note:**

Our activities this year were heavily influenced by the COVID-19 Pandemic. While many new projects began to be developed this year, only delivered projects were included in the mapping. Additionally, the mapping conducted in 2020 mapped our activities over the previous three years, from 2017, whilst the 2021 mapping only included activities from that year.
